There are several websites which are an excellent resource to practise Maths including Hit the Button, TopMarks and Times Table Rockstars. Children are regularly assessed in class and will also spend time in school practising these challenges.

<p>Number pairs to 10, 20 and 100: addition and subtraction.</p> <p>Example: $17 + 3 = 20$ $1 + 9 = 10$ $10 + 90 = 100$ $17 + 3 = 20$</p>	<p>Rapid recall of the 4x table and related division facts. This follows the 2x table as it can be worked out by doubling the 2x table answers.</p> <p>Example $7 \times 4 = 28$ $7 \times 2 = 14$ Double 14 = 28</p>	<p>Rapid recall of the 3x table and related division facts.</p> <p>Example: $2 \times 3 = 6$ $3 \times 2 = 6$ $6 \div 3 = 2$ $6 \div 2 = 3$</p>
