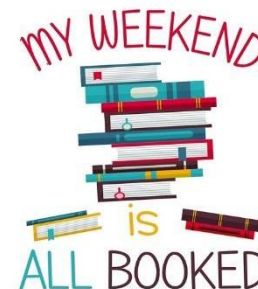




SFS READING ACTIVITIES

<p>1. Write 5 sentences including adverbs about events that have happened in the story you are reading.</p> <p>VCOP – Underline the adverbs in red</p>	<p>2. Draw your favourite character from the book you are reading. create a web around your drawing of adjectives to describe them.</p> <p>VCOP – Underline the adjectives in red</p>	<p>3. Write a letter to the author of the book you are reading telling them what you enjoyed about the story and why.</p> <p>Remember to use a wide variety of openers in your letter.</p> <p>VCOP – Underline the openers in blue</p>	<p>4. Write a different ending to a story you have enjoyed reading</p> <p>VCOP – Circle the verbs you have used in red.</p>
<p>5. Draw your favourite part of the story you have read and write a paragraph explaining why you chose this.</p> <p>Remember to use some connectives/conjunctions e.g. because, also, although, but, so</p> <p>VCOP – Underline connectives/conjunctions in red</p>	<p>6. Write a description of the setting in the book you are reading.</p> <p>Remember to use a wide variety of adjectives in your description.</p> <p>VCOP – Underline the adjectives in red</p>	<p>8. Write a book review for what you are reading.</p> <p>Remember to use the following headings: Title, Author, Genre, Summary of Text, Age suitability, Why I would/would not recommend this book, Star Rating.</p>
<p>9. Imagine you and the main character in the book are having a conversation.</p> <p>Write down your questions and the detailed responses their character would give.</p>	<p>10. Create your own blurb for the book you have read.</p> <p>Remember you are trying to sell the book to other people, be descriptive in your writing.</p> <p>VCOP - circle the punctuation in yellow</p>	<p>11. Design a new front cover for your book.</p> <p>Remember to include the title and the author of the book.</p>	<p>12. Write a letter to the author of your book and tell them what you thought of their book.</p> <p>Be honest and explain your opinions.</p> <p>VCOP – Underline the conjunctions in green</p>
