Create your own blurb for the book you have read. Remember you are trying to sell the book to other people, be descriptive in your writing. VCOP - circle the punctuation in yellow	11. Design a new front cover for your book. Remember to include the title and the author of the book.	12. Write a letter to the author of your book and tell them what you thought of their book.
